3. 4.	Making Connections Parent Symposium - update	Commissioning service is for all school councils – new membership would be encouraged at the service. Commissionings were done regionally this school year, some were well done and well attended. Task people to go into discussion at the commissioning. Networking sessions – in your community of schools – could also plan another evening gathering to talk about best practices – meet at a elementary or secondary school.  At our September meeting commissioning service meetings will be an agenda item. Committee agreed on terms being from November to November. Should principals be involved in this committee?  Looks as though the Ministry may be set to change the mandate of the Parent involvement Committee. What does the group think about our existing mandate? How do the members envision the different roles between the parents and the trustees?  Concern around the role of PIC's and how that will impact the role of the trustees going forward.
